

RESOLUTION NO. 15-06, 2015
COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF LEVYING A TAX IN
EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION WITHIN THE
UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE
OF PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE OR
REFUSE, INCLUDING YARD WASTE IN THE COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP
WASTE DISTRICT AND REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO
CERTIFY MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying a tax under RC 5705.03 outside the ten-mill limitation must be passed and certified to the county auditor of Hamilton County in order to permit the Board of Trustees to consider the levy of such a tax and must request that the County Auditor certify to the Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of the Columbia Township Waste District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is an emergency necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare because of the Board of Elections deadline for placing a levy on the November 3, 2015 election ballot,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees, for the benefit and welfare of the Columbia Township Waste District, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy 5.1 mills for the collection and disposal of garbage or refuse, including yard waste, to constitute a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Columbia Township Waste District for the purpose under RC 5705.19(v) or RC 505.27 – RC 505.33 providing for the collection and disposal of garbage or refuse, including yard waste, at a rate not exceeding 5.1 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 51 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation and; be it further

RESOLVED, that the levy be placed upon the tax lists of the current tax year, commencing in January, first due in calendar year 2016, in compliance with Ohio Revised Code section 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof and; be it further

RESOLVED, that the levy shall be a 3-year levy for the period January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2018 and in accordance with the law; be it further

RESOLVED, that the question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of Columbia Township at the election to be held therein on November 3, 2015 and; be it further

RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify a copy of the resolution to the County Auditor and Board of Elections, Hamilton County, Ohio. The Board of Trustees hereby requests that the County Auditor certify to this Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of the Columbia Township Waste District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax levy if approved by the electors and; be it further

RESOLVED, this resolution is an emergency.
