**AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF 200 TONS OF ROAD SALT AT \$58.82/TON; AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of Columbia Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, for the benefit and welfare of Columbia Township and its citizens hereby approves the purchase of 200 tons of road salt from Morton Salt at \$58.82/ton or \$11,764.00.
