**AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN
APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION
STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED
FOR BUCKINGHAM PLACE, CAMBRIDGE AVENUE, AND MURRAY AVENUE; AND
TO DECLARE EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Columbia Township is planning to make capital Improvements to various streets and infrastructure in need of repair, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the Township. The reason for the emergency is the submission deadline for grant applications.






Section 1: The Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.
